- visiting the Crown Courts to see trial processes in action

We will work with a range of community justice practitioners including representatives from the Police Service, victim support organisations, the Probation Service and the National Crime Agency as well as charitable organisations including Homeless Action.

This qualification is suitable for learners who want to progress onto degree courses in a range of Social Science disciplines including Criminology, Sociology and Social Policy. It also provides a solid foundation for further learning in workplace environments including legal settings, public services and charitable organisations.
